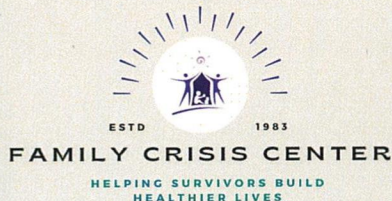


WHO ARE WE

Step 1

Let us hear your story

Begin creating a safer situation for you and your family by speaking with us so we can understand your situation.

Step 2

Risk Assessment

Many times, victims are not fully aware of the dangers they face. We want our clients to be aware of this in situations of abuse.

Step 3

Safety Planning

After the risk assessment, we will work with you to develop a plan that will provide short-term solutions to keep you and your family safe.

Step 4

Service Plan

We walk with you to help identify a long-term Empowerment plan. This is where we break down the steps and tools needed to a live a violence-free life.
